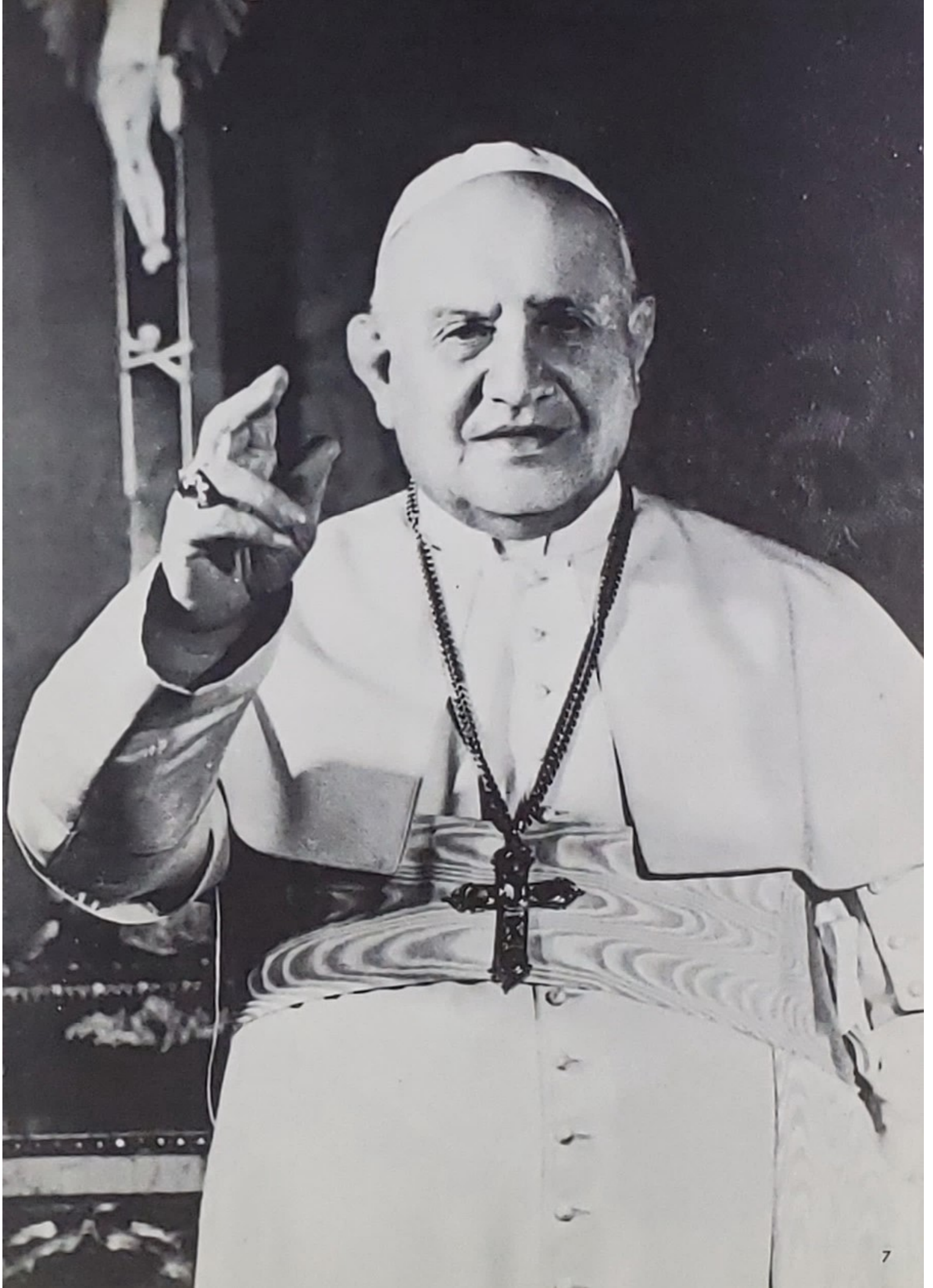
## John XXIII

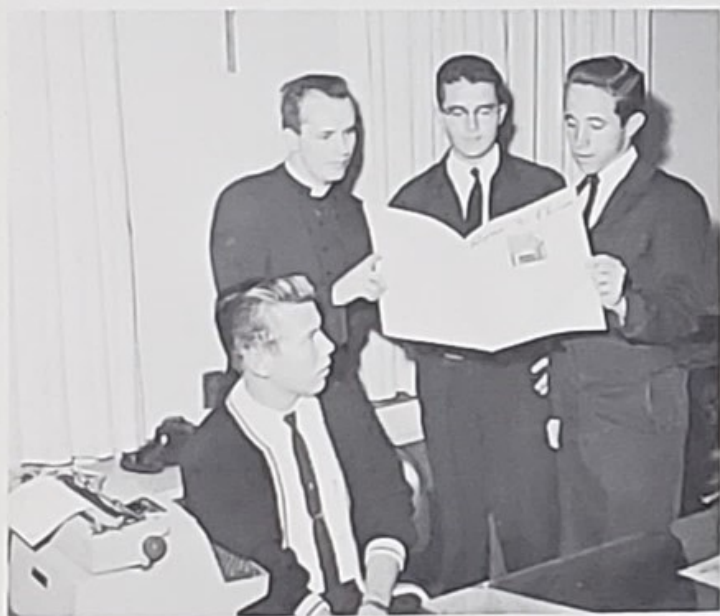
