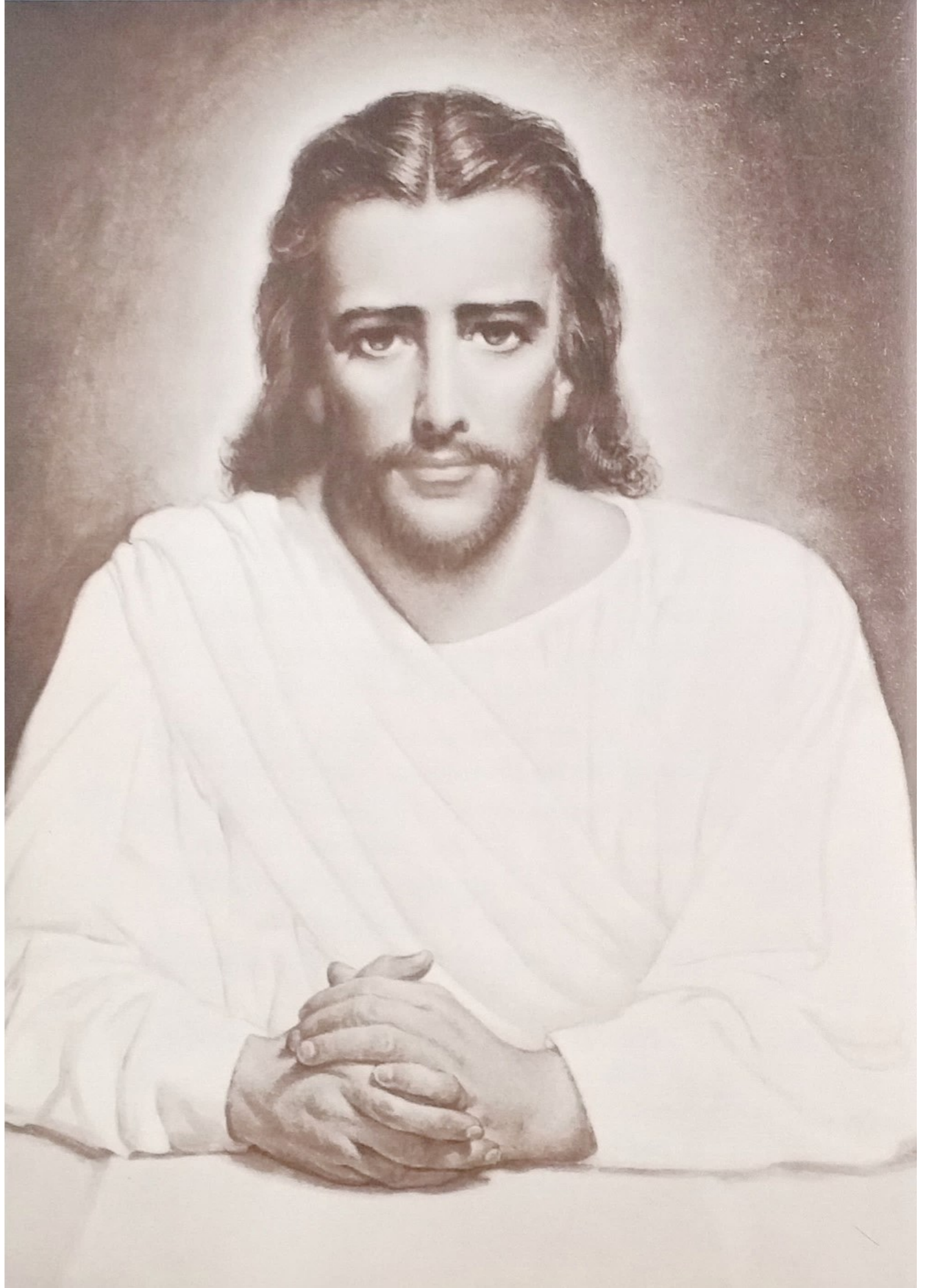
"Behold I Am With You All Days"

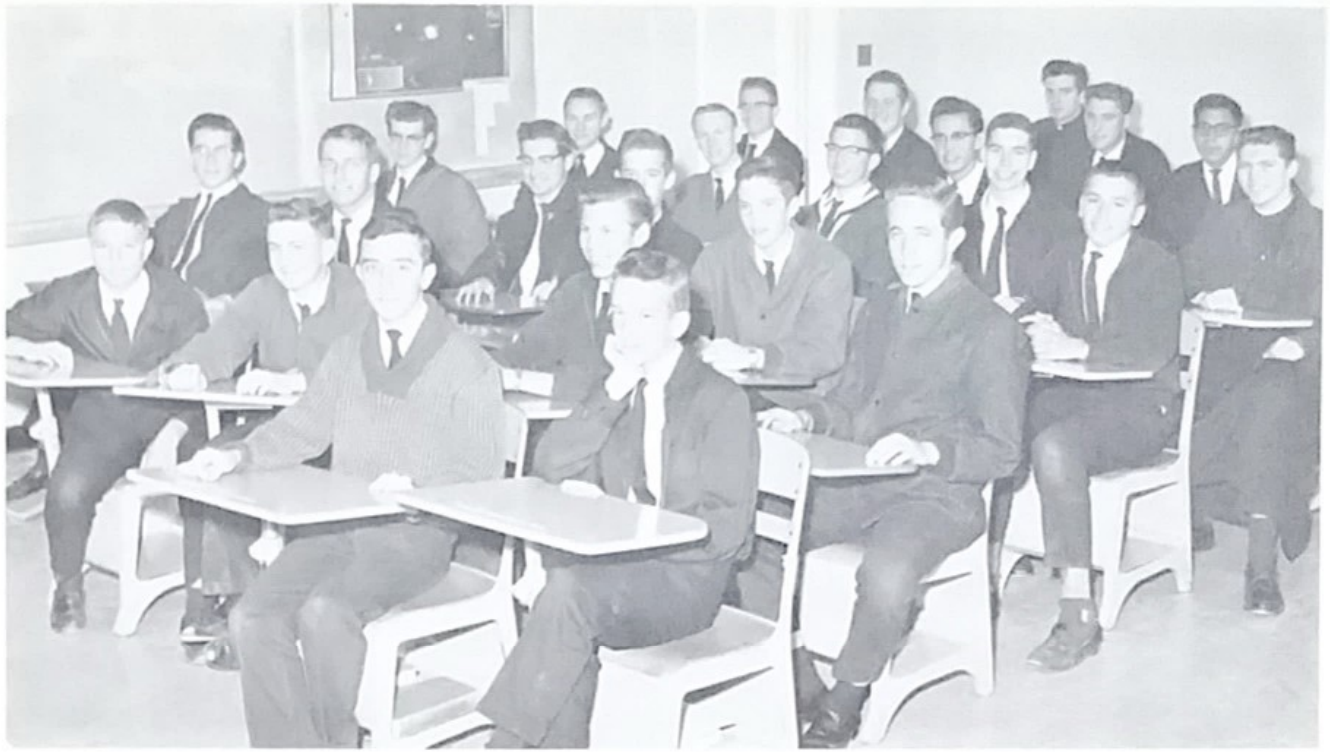

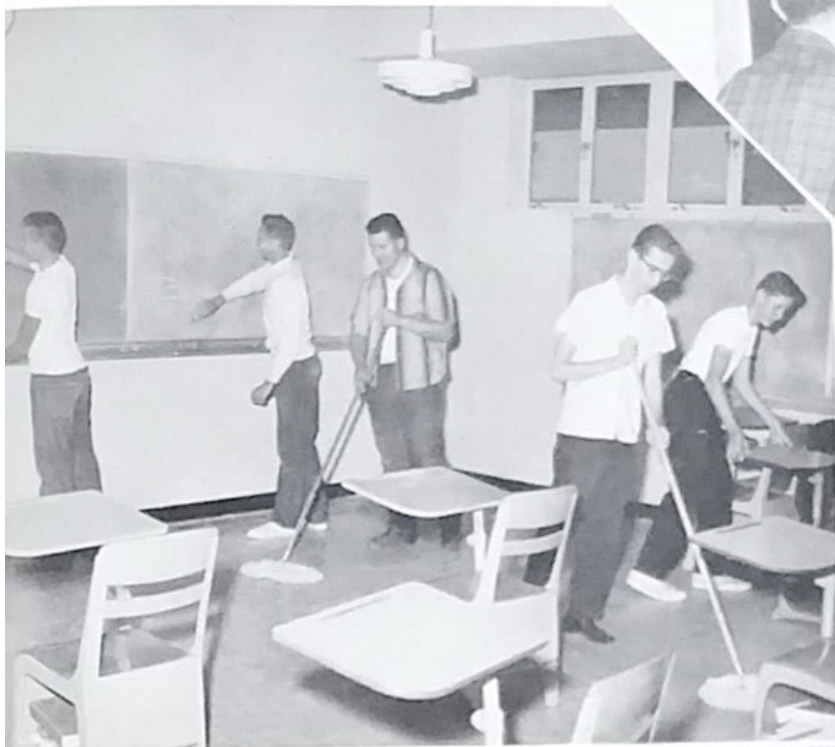
