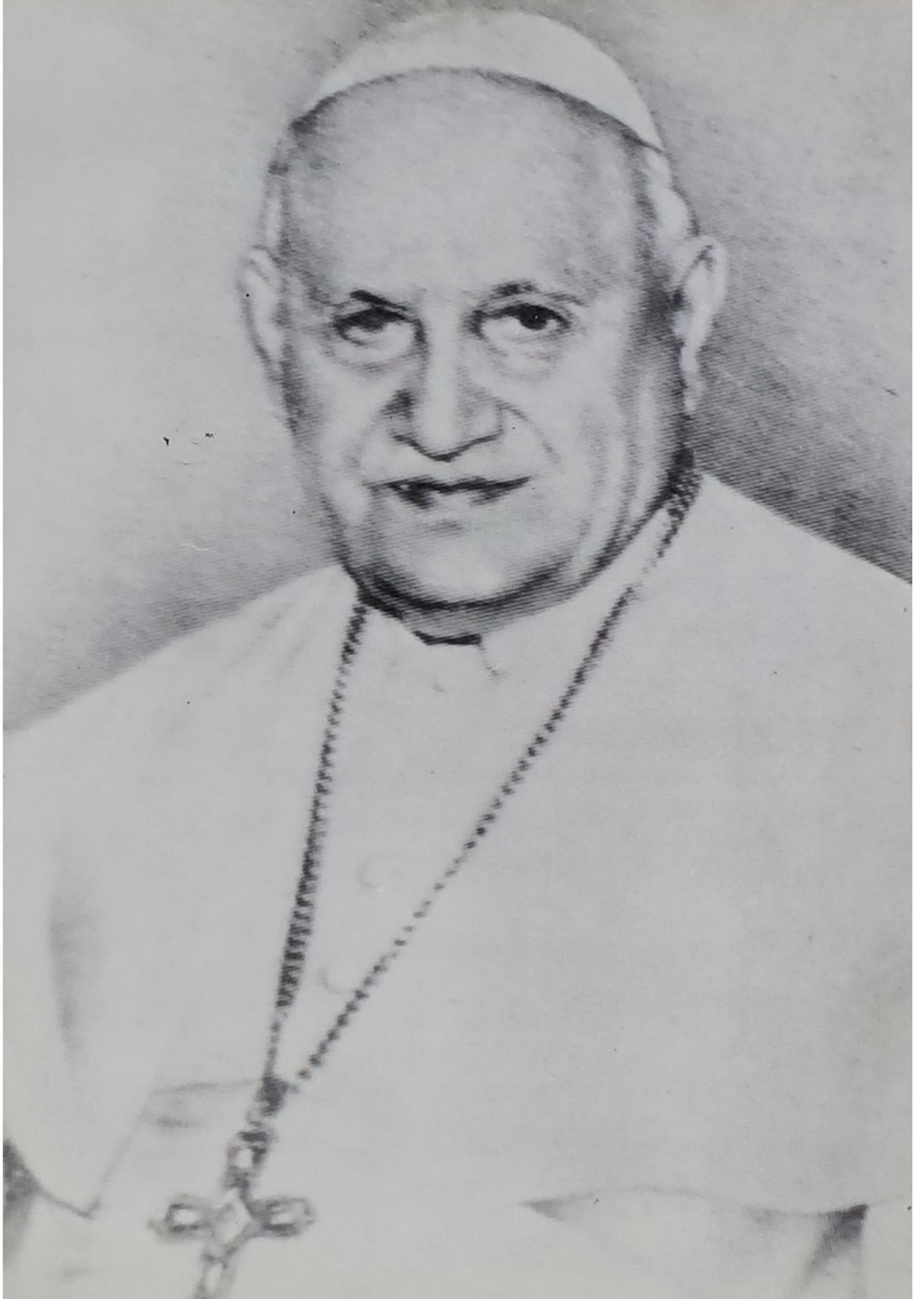

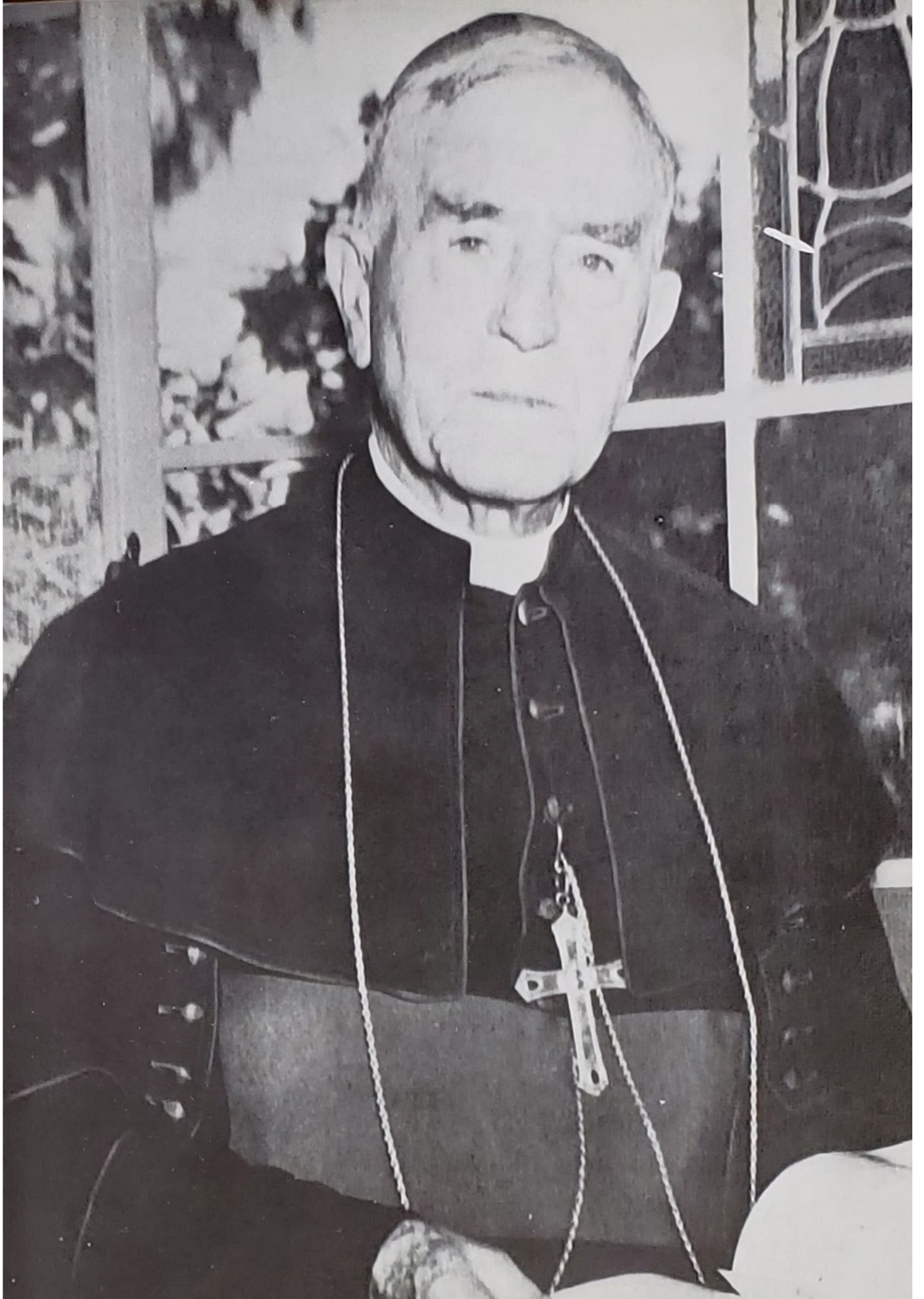
To no other is granted power to forgive sins. No wonder then that Saint Augustine exclaims: "O priests if priestly you shall have lived, how happy you shall be."

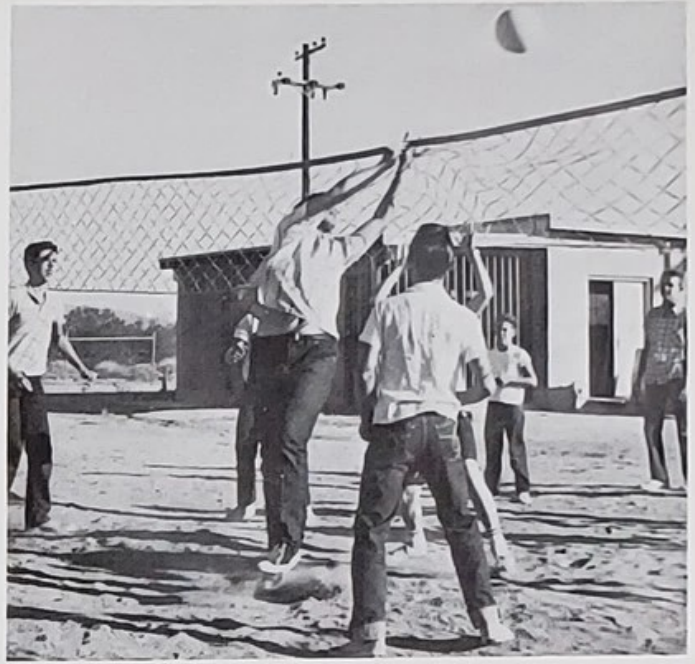
